- **Use the CARE Card** for prayer requests, to request information, to get on our mailing list, for communication with the staff, to sign up for classes, etc. Please drop your card in an offering box.

If you would like to speak to someone about how to become a Christian, or would like to pray with someone concerning a need in your life, I, and a couple of women from our Women's Care Team, will be at the front of the auditorium after the service.
