“Care Notes” offer counsel for various personal and emotional needs. They are in a rack at the back of the auditorium. Some of them available to you are:

1. Finding Strength to Survive a Crisis or Tragedy – “Your world has fallen apart...but your life goes on. You wonder how you will ever get through.” Where to find hope.
2. Loving Someone with a Drinking Problem – “This can be a devastating, heartbreaking experience. It is extremely difficult to love that person while hating their drug-affected behavior.” How to reach out – in three directions.
3. Climbing Up from Depression – “Sometimes depression lingers, in spite of your best efforts to pull out of it. There are ways to again find the view from your window contains beauty and hope.”

Welcome to Trinity

This past Wednesday was Ash Wednesday, signaling the beginning of the Lenten Season. Lent is a time in which we walk to the cross and prepare for Easter by understanding our need for Jesus to be crucified. This morning we begin a new series entitled “Walking with Jesus to the Cross.” We will explore select episodes from that fateful and prophesied last week in which Jesus walked to the cross, using these Sundays to prepare our hearts in humility for Easter.

If this is your first time here, I want to welcome you and encourage you to join with us as we gather to honor God and seek to learn from the Bible. Here are several things to help you:

- **Childcare for infants - 3 years** is available downstairs in rooms 104-108. Pagers are available.
- **Mothers’ Room** is available for fussy babies or nursing moms. Located at the back of the auditorium.
- **Children’s Church:** ages 4 – 1st Grade. Start in “Big Church” and are dismissed about 11:00 am to go to Room 103.
- **Jr. Church:** 2nd – 5th grade. Start in “Big Church” and are dismissed about 11:00 am to go to Room 201.
- **Use the CARE Card** for prayer requests, to request information, to get on our mailing list, for communication with the staff, to sign up for classes, etc. Please drop your card in the designated box by the main entrance doors or an offering box.

If you would like to speak to someone about how to become a Christian, or would like someone to pray with you concerning a need in your life, please come to the front of the church at the close of the service, or check the box on your CARE Card and drop it in any offering box and I will personally contact you. Pastor Steve

- **Offering Boxes** are located in the back of the auditorium and in the main lobby for you to drop your offering and CARE Cards in.
- **Assistive Listening Units** are available for anyone who has difficulty hearing in our auditorium. Please see an usher to get one.
