- **Childcare for infants - 3 years** is available downstairs in rooms 104-108. Pagers are available.

- **Children's Church:** ages 4 – 1st Grade. Start in "Big Church" and are dismissed about 11:00 am to go to Room 103.

- **Use the CARE Card** for prayer requests, to request information, to get on our mailing list, for communication with the staff, to sign up for classes, etc. Please drop your card in the designated box by the main entrance doors or an offering box.

If you would like to speak to someone about how to become a Christian, or would like someone to pray with you concerning a need in your life, please come to the front of the church at the close of the service, or check the box on your CARE Card and drop it in any offering box and I will personally contact you.
