*The mantra of the '60s was “Question Authority!” That may be needed in some cases, but it can also get a person in big trouble when the authority is right. The religious leaders of Jesus’ day didn’t get it right when they questioned Jesus’ authority. This morning we continue our series on Jesus’ walk to the cross and look at how our response to authority is an essential factor of our Christian life and relationship with God.*
